


In Awetest 2.5 we introduced a new feature that allows users to download all Project Assets (Scripts, Libraries, Custom Steps, Data Source/Excel Files, etc.) for a specific Project. This downloads all the assets into a zip file (that retains the Awetest folder structure) - allowing the user to upload the zip file into a NEW Awetest Project.

This makes the assets very portable allowing users to export and share their assets. This also alleviates the pain of having to download individual scripts and re-upload them one at a time.


Please Note: You will only be able to upload the zip file to a New Awetest project. You will not be able to upload the zip file to a project that has existing assets already added to it.

Step 1: Downloading Project Assets


- From the home screen of www.awetest.com go to Management.



- There you'll see your list of projects and a Download button on the right, click it.




- The entire project library along with all of its meta data and file structure will be downloaded in a .zip file. When you unzip the file you will see all of the project assets and libraries.




Step 2: Uploading Project Assets


- Within Management > Projects click Add New Project



- Add Project name then Save



- Now the Abbreviation for the project has been prepopulated and you can now click the upload icon



- Choose the file from your computer to upload then click Restore and your project will be uploaded into Awetest
