


With the added feature of being able to create a template job in Awetest 2.5 users can now have job settings that they repetitively use and save them as a template. This makes it extremely easy to efficiently run tests that need to be run multiple times with just the push of a button.


The job template can be customized to fit any desired test case/environment/worker environment combination.

See the following document for step-by-step instructions:

- From the home screen of www.awetest.com go to Web > Jobs.



- From the Jobs page click “Add a New Job”.



- Select the combination of test cases/environments/worker behavior you'd like and click the box for "Save this job as a template." Then give your template a name, and click Save.

- Now under Web > Jobs > Template you can see all of your saved templates and can easily re-run any of the tests by clicking the Restart button at the right.
