



The “Debug” option is by default turned off, but when desired the Debug option can be turned on before running a test and a log icon will appear on the job report. This log is all of the data sent back and forth from the Shamisen throughout the test, and by adding the option to not log this data it clears up a lot of stress on the system.

- From the home screen of www.awetest.com go to Web > Jobs.



- Click Add New Job.



- Select the combination of test cases/environments/worker behavior you'd like and click the box for Debug, then Run.



